Do you work as a teacher or school staff? Do you feel passionate about what you do, but wish you could use your skills for an eternal purpose? The Bible translation task needs you!

Wycliffe's goal is to see that God's Word is translated for people in the language they know and can understand best. Teachers and school support staff are critical to this purpose. You could be part of the dynamic team committed to see this happen.

The Need

Wycliffe is looking for people who are willing to play their part on the translation team by providing education for the children of Wycliffe personnel serving abroad. Wycliffe offers a wide variety of opportunities for teachers, school administrators, librarians, resource teachers and children's home parents. Educators are always in great demand—we need more than 100 every year.

What's Involved

Wycliffe places teachers in dozens of schools worldwide, ranging in size from a single classroom to a facility with 700-plus students. Some teachers serve on the staff of an inter-mission, or international school. The curriculum of each school reflects the specific needs of its student body and will depend largely on the nationalities of the students.

Adventure-seeking teachers are prime candidates for nontraditional programs. In many countries, missionary families work in remote areas, far from an appropriate traditional school option. For these situations, Wycliffe needs teachers to serve as private tutors for a single family; itinerant teachers rotating between several families; correspondence or Internet school supervisors; or education consultants. Preschool teachers and nursery workers may also be needed in some locations.

Qualifications & Training

Kindergarten through high school personnel need certification from a province and/or the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). Generally, we recommend at least one successful year of teaching experience. Preschool teachers do not need a credential but should have an associate's degree and preschool experience. They should also have the willingness and flexibility to teach students of other cultures and nationalities. Children's home parents should have a love for teenage students, successful experience with the group, flexibility, household management skills, a strong marriage and emotional/physical health. Successful applicants will be required to raise financial support from interested friends, family and churches. Training and resources are provided for this.
